AUTHORISATION: To sell and supply liquor in accordance with Section 36 of the Liquor Licensing Act 1997 and any other conditions of this licence.

ENTERTAINMENT CONSENT: Outlined in blue on the plan and shown as Area 1.

RESPONSIBLE PERSONS: Under Section 97(2) of the Act an exemption is granted from the requirements of subsection (1)(a).

CAPACITIES:

Area 1	200 persons
Area 2	45 persons
Area 3	50 persons
Area 4	45 persons
Area 5	150 persons

There shall be no more than 400 persons on the licensed area at any one time.

IMPORTANT: The licensee is obliged to maintain all essential safety provisions as required by Regulation 76 of the Regulations made under the Development Act 1993.

LIQUOR AND GAMBLING COMMISSIONER

CONDITIONS:-

The licence shall operate each year between 1 October to the 31 March.

The adjacent area is to be permanently defined by posts connected by chains, at the eastern and western boundaries with a permanent warning sign attached to the chains notifying members of the public that they are entering the licensed area.

Under section 43(1) of the Act, I impose the following conditions in relation to trading hours for the period 1 October to 31 March:-

Areas 1, 3 & 5:-

Monday to Friday	4pm to 11pm
Saturday	midday to midnight
Sunday	midday to 10pm (subject to review by Council)

Areas 2 & 4:-

Monday to Friday	4pm to 8pm	(during daylight savings when games are in progress, otherwise 4pm to 6pm)
Saturday and Sunday	midday to 8pm	(during daylight savings when games are in progress, otherwise 4pm to 6pm)

This licence is subject to the following agreement between the club and the licensing authority:

- the club will not, during the currency of the licence, hold a gaming machine licence
- the club will not sell or supply liquor under the licence except for consumption on the club premises by -
 - a) a member of the club; or
 - b) a guest of a member who is also present on the club premises
- a member of the club will not be permitted by the club to have more than 5 guests on the club premises at any one time

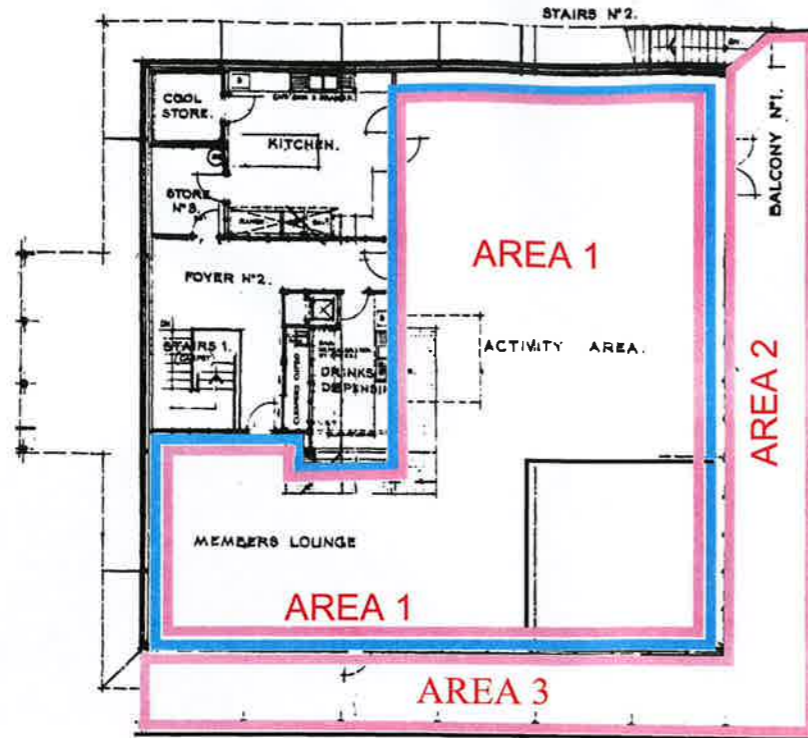

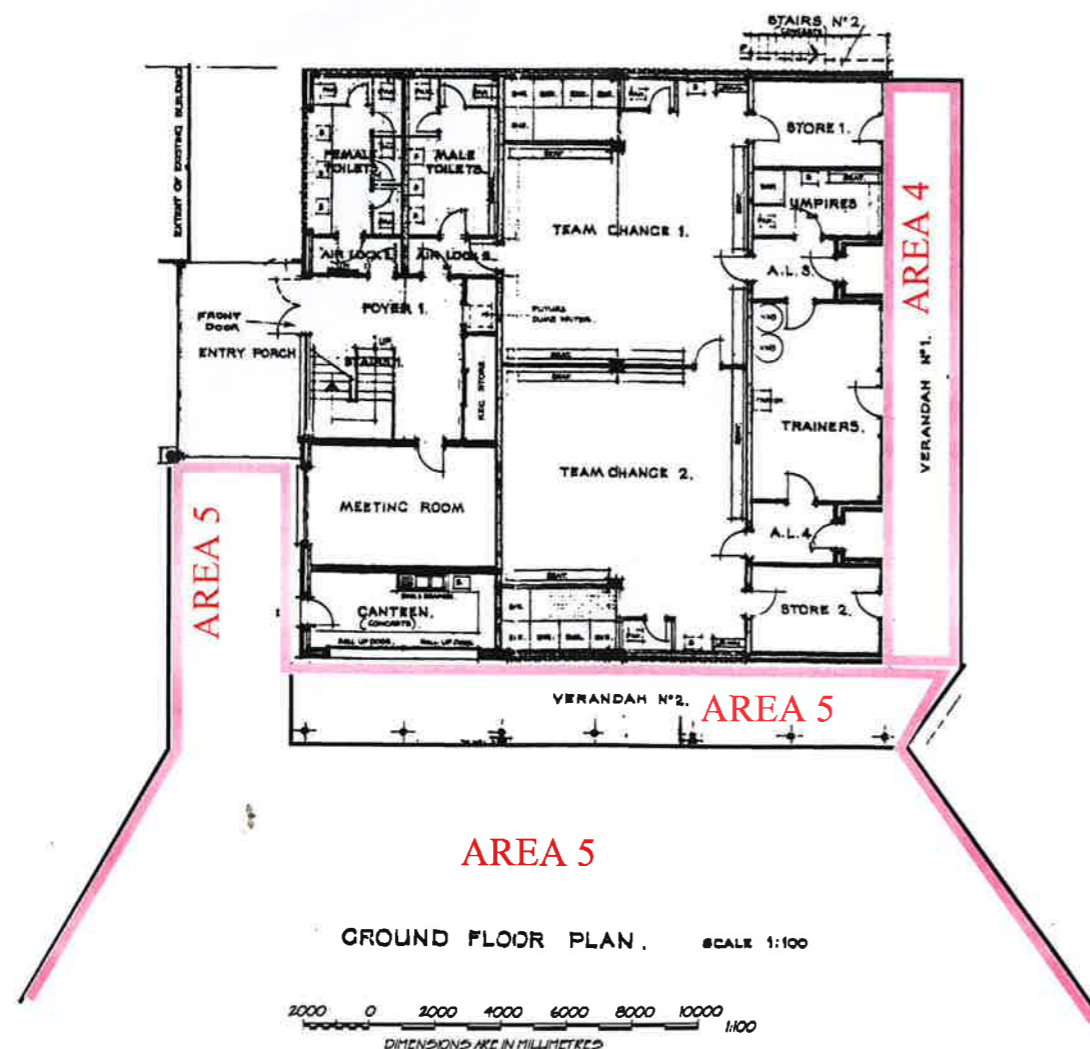
